Cleanup of former plating facility (Los Angeles, California)

The property owner of an abandoned nickel and chrome plating facility that had received an EPA Administrative Order to immediately clean up the site retained Lindmark Engineering. The chemicals of concern were heavy metals, acids, alkalines, and cyanides. In order to meet the fast-track requirements of this project, we expedited submittal of a work plan and reports and obtained competitive bids from cleanup contractors for decontaminating, handling and disposing all hazardous and nonhazardous waste. Following above-grade decontamination, limited demolition and cleanup, we excavated the contaminated soil to meet EPA Region IX Preliminary Remediation goals, and the site was closed by EPA Region IX. *Client: De Angelis, et al.
